



Lay in roughly, using oval technique. Be careful to keep layout lines in perspective.



Sketch the bridle in lightly with Burnt Sienna, using White for buckles and bit ring. Black pastel for dark areas, White for blaze.



Black pastel is used lightly where velure shows through, then Blue pastel is used over same areas giving desired highlights.

Black horses are hardest of all colors to paint in pastel or oil. I used Black pastel here; if this were oil I would use Ivory Black.



Blue pastel is used for highlights in this detail work on leather.

NATIVE DIVER certainly belongs in the Gallery of Champions. The horse players Black Beauty, he was the stuff of which the romance of the turf is made. He was a tall, racy gelding and became a public idol, with winnings of \$1,126,500.00. He became California's first equine millionaire, but his career was abruptly terminated by enterotoxemia in 1967. He is interred at Hollywood Park.
